Christmas Gift Ideas for The Fisherperson in Your Family by Gary Davisson



It's that time of year when I get calls or e-mails from the wives of my fishing buddies asking for Christmas gift ideas. Thought I would jot down a few ideas and share them with you. I have tried to list the companies that make these products but it is a place for you to start your research.



Tippet - Every fisherperson can always use tippet, in sizes 5x, 6x and 7x. If he/she doesn't have a tippet holder that attaches to the vest or pack they use, get that with the tippet spools.



Tapered Leaders - Some fisherpersons make their leaders but having some ready to attach to your fly line is really nice. They come in different lengths but around here the most common is a 5x, 6x, and 7x (9'-0" long). Great to have in your vest or pack.



Leader Wallet - Really handy to keep your store bought or hand made leaders organized.



Not everyone needs one of these but I have found as I get older this is a welcome addition to my travel gear. I prefer to staying dry versus a cold dip in the river.



So many people are using the camera on their phones instead of using a good digital camera. I really don't like carrying my phone out on the water unless I'm in a boat and then I put it in a dry bag. A good waterproof digital camera is what every fisherperson needs. You can take pictures or video underwater of the catch or release of the your catch and you do not care if it gets wet. The #1 rated waterproof camera is the Olympus TC5, #2 - GoPro Hero 6, #3 - Nikon, #4 - Ricoh WG50. These cameras range from \$230-\$358.



A good plier is a great addition to your fishing arsenal. Make your hook removal much easier, doesn't corrode, most have replaceable blades and they come in a variety of colors. There at numerous manufactures such as Simms, Orvis, Abel, Hatch or Dr. Slick. These vary widely in price.
